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Learning objectives

Get to know the school (organization, school projects, cycle projects ...).

Relationship between theoretical-conceptual frameworks and practical experiences: Contrast and compare professional observations and experiences with the theoretical frameworks of the education sciences as a reflection strategy to understand and explain reality, propose and implement improvements in actions.

Relate and compare the knowledge arising from the experience with the theoretical knowledge.

Relate practice and theory from the concerns and needs of one's own work.

Build a personal vision based on the information obtained and professional experience.

Mobilize the knowledge acquired in the interpretation of reality.

Analyze the practice from the skills to be developed.

Make substantiated proposals to improve the practice.

Teamwork: Acting cooperatively with others as a strategy for the development of a project or different educational

and / or social tasks that, by their nature, could not be carried out individually. The goal is to achieve a more satisfactory common outcome than would be achieved by working separately.

Establish good interpersonal relationships in the context of working with students and teachers. Fulfill the commitments made with the team. Respect and value the contributions made by team members. Encourage group work.

Subject contents

Methodology

20 ECTS, 500 hours

Hours at the training center where the internship is done: 70% = 350 hours (140h general and 210h mention)

Study, reflection and elaboration of documents: 26% = 130 hours

Tutoring hours (center and faculty): 3% = 15 hours

Evaluation hours: 1% = 5 hours

Evaluation

The evaluation of the Practicum will be done jointly by the tutor of the center and the tutor of the faculty (50%) and will take into account the following aspects. The part evaluated by a university tutor and the school must have been approved in order to average.

A. Quality of the didactic sequences designed and implemented.

- B. Acquired professional skills.
- C. Practicum Learning Folder.

The tutors of the center and of the Faculty will present a report on the development of the competitions of the student, as well as the proposals of improvement (ANNEX 3 to the document of practices that finds to resources).

The evaluation provided by the student, from their experiences in the professional settings, reflects a critical and self-critical vision, their strengths and weaknesses, making proposals for improvement towards future experiences (ANNEX 4, in the internship document that is find resources).

All the documentation that is elaborated in each period of practices (report tutors + self-evaluation and proposals of improvement) will collect and will serve to realize the follow-up of each student.
