DUAL MODE

The following types of activities will be carried out during the course:

1-Reflective records of educational situations at the school.

The student will carry out a minimum of four reflective processes on school situations, which he must submit in accordance with the corresponding guidelines

2- Classroom intervention observed by the tutor.

The student will plan and carry out a classroom intervention that will be observed and commented on by the tutor. The planning should be given to the mentor and tutor in advance

3. Collection of own interventions in the classroom.

The student must keep a record of all the actions he carries out in the classroom and at school, with the corresponding evidence. You will need to perform and register a minimum of 2 performances per week.

4. "Critical Friendship" activity.

The student must observe the classroom intervention of a colleague and comment on it in accordance with a guideline that will be provided.

5. Readings.

The student must read and work on a minimum of two readings, proposed by the tutor.
