The general objective of the subject is to carry out an analysis of the role and public sector performance in the economy and also know the characteristics and economic effects of expenditure programmes and public revenues included in the public budget.

The specific aims are:

- interpret the information contained in the public budget
- identify market failure situations and evaluate the different public instruments to solve them
- . judge the degree of efficiency and equity of a public expenditure programme
- . judge the degree of equity and efficiency of taxation. Measure tax progressivity and identify tax incidence situations
- assess the funding model of the Spanish Autonomous Governments on the basis of the principles of financial autonomy and solidarity
- know the structure of the resources of Spanish local authorities

Evaluation

Continuous assessment

The final grade for the course is obtained from the weighted average of the grades obtained in the evaluation activities, according to the weight assigned to each of them. The test of week 4,9, 13 and 17 the test are individual and are mandatory. The activities proposed throughout the course are also mandatory and must be carried out following the instructions that will be available on the virtual campus. These are activities that students must deliver throughout the course. Some of these activities will take place in the classroom and will be notified in advance. The criteria relating to the grade NOT PRESENTED is as follows: the students who obtain grades in only two or fewer evaluation activities will obtain the grade of NOT PRESENTED as a final grade for the subject.

In total there are 100 points:

- 1.- Block 1. Between weeks 1 and 15: Various activities (40 points)
- 2.- Block 2. Week 4. Topic 1 (15 points).
- 3.- Block 3 (09/04/24- 18,00 h.-Classroom 0.31, FDET). Week 9. Topic 2 (15 points).
4. Block 4. Week 12. Topic 3 (15 points).
- 5.- Block 5. Week 17 (07/06/24- 9h- Classroom 0.31, FDET). Topic 4 (15 points).

Alternative assessment

According to the Regulations for the evaluation and qualification of teaching in the degrees and masters of the University of Lleida (article 1.5), in the event that a student documents the impossibility of attending the programmed activities within the continuous evaluation (for paid work, second or subsequent enrollment of the
