The Catalan avant-garde in relation to its European context.

Reading a work by Salvat-Papasseit or J. V. Foix.

Learning objectives

- Let the student understand and assimilate that the establishment of a program such as this one, from the general to the individual (cultural context → theoretical framework → literary practice), presupposes a prior analysis that has followed the reverse process.
- Let it be realized, therefore, that in order to make and understand the history of literature, there is a direct and profound knowledge of the original, theoretical and practical texts that make it up. So:
- Let him know how to extract from a programmatic text given the theoretical content that expresses it and is able to relate it to the author's and aesthetic context of the period; i
- That you can trace and justify these theoretical contents in the literary practice of the texts. And, in the alternative,
- Let them familiarize yourself with the handling of the variant apparatus of the critical editions and know how to interpret them.
