#### Subject's extra information

Assignment of acquisition of knowledge about Occitan of the Vall d'Aran which mainly pursues that the student obtains a practical competition in Aranese while being able to identify and scientifically reason the linguistic facts that characterize this variety. The subject should therefore suppose a leap forward in the study and acquisition of Occitan from the contents related to the oc language obtained previously in the same degree in Catalan and Occitan Studies. Linguistic contents are accompanied by a necessary approach to Aranese history, geography and culture, as well as the process of officialization and promotion of Occitan in the Aran Valley, to the legal provisions that affect it and the sociolinguistic reality of the Gascon to the south of the Franco-Spanish border.

- 3.5 Other issues of morphology.
- 3.6 Syntactic affairs. Uses of prepositions a, en, entà, per.
- 3.7 Basic lexicon (I)
- 3.8 Basic lexicon (II)
- 4-Dialectological approach to the dialects of the Vall d'Aran. Heterogeneity of Aranese (one week).
- 5-Contributions to the dialectological study of Aranese: from Bernard Sarrieu to Joan Coromines (one week).
- 6-High Aranese, Low Aranese and Central Aranese. Affinities with the neighboring Romanesque dialects (one week).
