Basic contents of the subject

Module V of the Degree in Biomedical Sciences consists of the Practicum (24 ECTS credits) and the Final Degree Project (TFG, 6 ECTS credits). The Practicum must have a 19-week stay in a research laboratory. A report will be drawn up on this stay, which will constitute the Final Degree Project (TFG).

Development plan of the subject

The TFG will consist of a memory related to the task carried out during the internship. It will have a scientific format that includes: Introduction, Objectives, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion and Bibliography.

This report will not be more than 40 pages long. The report will need to be reviewed by the TFG tutor and optionally by the host lab supervisor.

In the month of July the student will have to present the work done during the stay before a court formed by the coordinator of module V, the tutor and another teacher. This exhibition will last around 15 minutes with the subsequent question time.

Deadlines for submitting the report and oral presentation dates will be indicated by the coordinator through the virtual campus.
