Methodology

Teaching methodologies

- Master classes: presentation of the contents of the subject orally by the teacher.
- Presentations: presentation of previously assigned class texts.
- Directed debate: oral expression and comprehension will be promoted in a group conversation in class.
- Lectures: public presentation on a topic carried out by an expert.
- Class activities: case analysis, critical reviews and / or revisions of the work.

The non-contact sessions will consist of the presentation of the result of the works that will have been commissioned to the students in the previous face-to-face class, and the presentation by the teacher of the corresponding subject, which can be reinforced with some audiovisual projection.

In each face-to-face session there will be a mock press conference on a pre-determined question in class.

- Virtual sessions: 4 (26.10, 09.11, 23.11, 21.12) Presentations, analysis, debate and simulations of press conference

Evaluation
