Learning objectives

Complete the training of the student in the knowledge of the French language applied to the context of the world of tourism, making special emphasis on the four basic skills (oral and written comprehension and expression), in order to be able to hold a conversation in French language on topics that are familiar to him. Another of the main objectives is to enable the student to interpret any type of oral or written document, of low difficulty, and to deepen the oral and written skills applied to the French language of tourism.

Methodology

On the one hand, the teacher will present the linguistic and lexical elements included in the syllabus of the subject; through theoretical classes, concepts will be explained and tasks will be exemplified. On the other hand, listening and reading comprehension skills as well as oral and written expression will be put into practice (oral presentations, participation in simulation activities, search for materials and work with audiovisual and online resources), all of them in relationship with the world of tourism. Given the eminently practical and instrumental nature of this subject, a very active participation by students in face-to-face sessions as well as in non-face-to-face sessions is required.

All written and oral activities proposed throughout the course are mandatory. The **final grade** will result from the sum of the grades for each activity mentioned in the table, taking into account the minimum percentages to pass the different tests. If the minimum percentages established in the mentioned evaluation activities are not reached, the subject will not be able to be passed. The final grade cannot be NOT PRESENTED in case of failing the subject.

Alternative evaluation: In the event that a student documents his / her impossibility to attend the activities scheduled within the continuous assessment (for paid work, second or subsequent registration of the subject, conciliation of work and family life and mobility stays) you will be able to opt for a single test to validate skills and knowledge. This test is subject to evaluation regulations, so that all tests that exceed the 30% percentage are subject to recovery. Students will also be entitled to a revision of the single assessment test.
