Territorial planning aims to guide the location of the population, economic activities and physical infrastructures, while respecting the criteria of economic growth, social development and conservation of the environment. To do this is based on the knowledge, potentialities and specific constraints of each area. In this subject, this discipline will be addressed from the point of view of managing the effects that the tourism phenomenon can generate over space.

This teaching guide is intended to be developed with a group of 20 to 25 enrolled. If the number increases or decreases significantly, some of the activities and evaluation criteria may undergo modifications that will be discussed when the registration is closed and the final number of students is available.

Methodology

The main methodological axes of the subject will be the following:

- 1. Level of general knowledge obtained in the field of processes and techniques of the planning of the territory. It will be evaluated after a final exam. It is a requirement to pass the subject to pass the final average 5 and at least the exam's score of 3'5.
- 2. Practical sorting work done during the course and presented in a timely manner as they are executed.
- 3. Assistance and use of the outings during the course.

Development plan

Distribution of the 60 hours of the subject:

- Theoretical classes: 40 hours + 2 hours exam

- Practical sessions: 8 hours

- Presentations of the work: 4 hours

- Departures (Lleida city - date to be specified): 6 hours

Evaluation

Review: 50% (there is recovery)

Practical work (no recovery):

Simulation work for a public tender (20% of the note)
Practical work on the basis of urban planning (20% of the note)

Assistance and use of the outputs: 10% of the mark (5% per exit) (there is no recovery). All those who can not attend must submit an official justification of the reasons (work, medical, legal obligations ...). In this case, the final note will be

calculated without the corresponding exit. If no supporting document is delivered, it will be understood that the exit note is 0.

Alternative assessment Alternative assessment: In the event that a student documentally proves that they are unable to attend scheduled activities in the continuous evaluation (for paid work, second or subsequent tuition of the subject ...), they can opt for a Unique test of validation of competences and knowledge that will be carried out on the day and in the schedule established in the calendar of evaluation of the Degree for the final test of the ordinary evaluation. This test will consist of an examination with contents expanded with some of the practices of the course. The application for this assessment modality must be carried out before October 15 with documentary accreditation and, once done, it can not be modified.
