- Relate academic knowledge (knowledge) with professional practices (know-how).
- Instill in students the right attitudes to know how to be in the world of work.
- Bringing universities closer to the business world.

## Development plan

The subject of Tutored Internships in Business has a teaching load of 9 credits, therefore, considering that each ECTS credit is equivalent to 25 hours of work by the student, it is a total of 225 hours, distributed as follows: This is equivalent to a total of 200 hours of stay in the company and the rest of the time is devoted to the writing of the report, academic tutorials and presentation of the report.

## Evaluation

The evaluation of the subject will consist of:

1. Student self-assessment (10%): assessment questionnaire made by the student where he will score on various aspects related to the realization of his practices and the relations with the various related actors.
2. Evaluation of the company (30%): evaluation questionnaire completed by the company, where the tutor in the company will score the completion of the internship by the student.
3. Evaluation of the report (40%): The report of the practices carried out by the student and the weekly follow-up sheets approved by the tutor of the company are evaluated by the academic tutor.
4. Evaluation of the presentation before the court (20%): presentation of the practices in public session by part of the student in front of a court composed by the coordinator university-company of the center, the academic tutor and another tutor of practices in business.
